


## Vision








Figure 1: Geographical location of Medicaid providers trained in all **research-informed practice** training **and evidence-based programs** sponsored by the Center for Evidence to Practice in 2019. Figure 2: Geographical location of Medicaid providers trained in Center sponsored **evidence-based** <u>programs</u> (TF-CBT, CPP, PPT, and PCIT) in 2019.





Figure 3: Geographical location of Medicaid providers trained in Center sponsored **research-informed <u>practice</u>** (MI and TBRI) in 2019.
