Q: Would we need a different training if we wanted to use this with children outside of the 2.5-7-year age range?

A: Yes. To go older or younger with the model takes additional training and supervision, however you need a good grasp on the model before trying to expand the age range of the model.

Q: Will all of the therapists need to be fully licensed?

A: It would be ideal for participants to be fully licensed, however we do accept provisionally licensed clinicians as well as clinicians who are working towards licensure/eligible to be licensed and will be licensed by the end of the training period. The training period takes one year.

Q: Would the model still be able to be implemented if you don't have access to a one-way window space in your agency/place of work?

A: There is some flexibility with having the one-way mirror and trainers will discuss possible options for implementing the model for agencies who do not have the necessary room set-up/a way to create the room set-up. Using a video stream with very clear resolution is a possible option.

Q: Are the 12 open slots for 12 agencies or 12 clinicians?

A: 12 clinicians. It could be 3 agencies with 4 people each, or 4 agencies with 3 people each. The exact makeup of the cohort will depend on the type of applications we receive.

Q: Will not having an additional clinician from my agency prevent me from getting into the training? I know my agency will be supportive, but we may not have another clinician to join.

A: Since the model requires a minimum of two clinicians to implement it as intended, we do aim to have at least two clinicians from each agency to apply, if not more. This allows for more support for the clinician to complete the training and learn the model with the most success.

Q: How long is the training period and duration to achieve certification?

A: The goal for each clinician accepted to this training opportunity is to complete all components required throughout the one (1) training year. That allows clinicians to be eligible to achieve and apply for certification by the end of the training year.

Q: What time will the consultation take place?

A: The timeslot for consultation calls is decided during the initial 5-day training period, so it will be decided collaboratively with the group to ensure all trainees can attend.

Q: Are we required to present a case during consultation?

A: Yes, you must execute the model with a client and present a case during consultation. It is best to attempt the model with multiple clients to ensure that you can complete the entire model at least once to be able to present it. You will learn a lot from presenting and discussing your cases during consultation, as well as listening to other trainees present their cases. These cases will be de-identified as to ensure no one is sharing protected health information.
