Q: How do I register for this opportunity?

A: This is not a certification course, this is just a learning opportunity for behavioral health providers. You are welcome to attend to learn more about the modality or check out our website to learn about other certification courses we offer. Also, we typically do not offer trainings to RNs, our trainings are targeted towards behavioral health providers. Some exceptions are made specifically for psychiatrically trained nurses.
