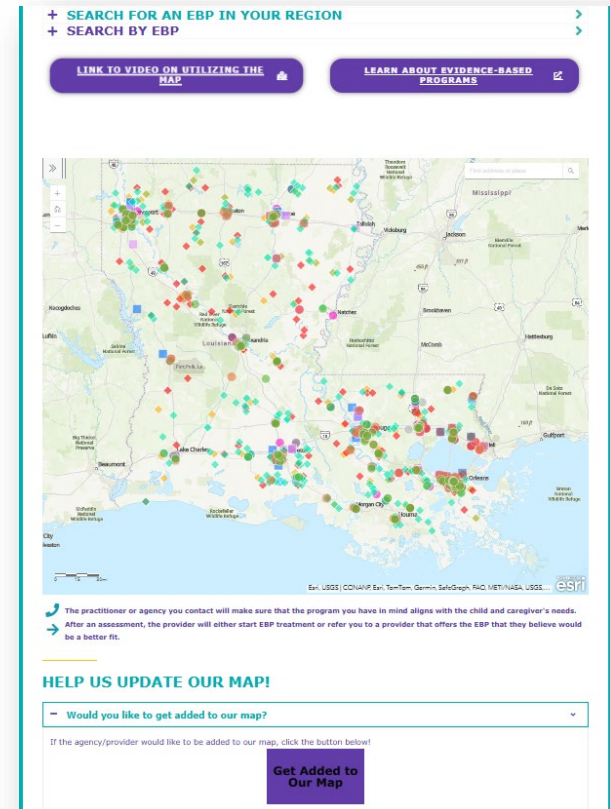

Facilitators of Training Completion

- Peer support
- Supervisor and administration support
- Well-established referral pipeline
- Commitment to consultation and learning the model
- Relationship with consultant

PCIT Agency Support

- Within agency peer supervision
- Caseload adjustment
- Referral pathways
- Website/Advertisement of Services
- Other Thoughts/Suggestions?

Barriers to Training Completion

- Case identification and selection
- Therapist reluctance to proceed
- Clients don't attend consistently
- Therapists don't attend consultation calls consistently

Common Challenges of PCIT Implementation

Clinicians:

- Cherry Picking: Waiting for the perfect case
- Only taking 1-2 cases
- Not preparing for sessions
- Attending by not participating in consultation calls
- Not seeking consultation when having difficulty with a case
- Not tracking case progress

What it Looks Like:

- “I don’t have any cases appropriate for PCIT.”
- “I explained the model, but the child and/or family was not interested.”
- “I didn’t have time to prepare for the session because.....”
- “I tried to do PCIT but the case has too many challenges”
- Catching up on notes, driving, or being distracted while in consultation meeting.”
- “I’m not sure where I am in the model”

Common Challenges of PCIT Implementation

Senior Leaders:

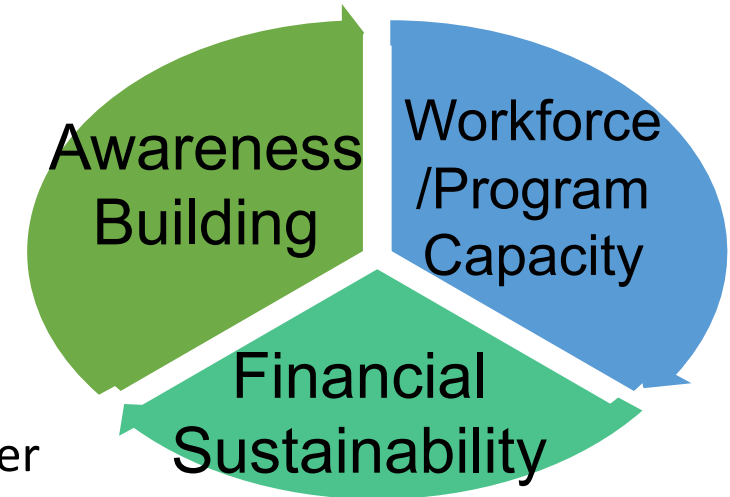
- Not leading regular team meetings
- Losing focus and not staying up-to-date on team participation
- Not using metrics to identify barriers to implementation
- Failing to recognize and celebrate successes

What it Looks Like:

- “We couldn’t find a time when everyone could meet.”
- “This pressing matter came up, so.....”
- Not reporting metrics back to the team

Growing PCIT at Your Agency

- Certified PCIT Clinicians
- **Continued Clinician Training**
- **Developing Within Agency Trainers**
- **PCIT Program Supervision**
- **PCIT Adaptations** exist for a number of family characteristics (Toddler, Older Child)
- **PCIT Fits a number of formats:** Telehealth, Intensive PCIT, Workshops, Group
- **Complementary Services:** In-Home Models- Behavioral Skills Training for Families.
- **Resources** (Brochures, Social Media Posts)

➤ **Qualification Standard**

- Certified in Parent-Child Interaction Therapy by PCIT International

➤ **Qualification Documentation**

- Certificate issued by PCIT International OR inclusion in the PCIT International list of Certified PCIT Therapists

➤ **Additional Information**

- After completing training and consultation that meets PCIT International training standards, PCIT practitioners must submit an application to PCIT International and complete a PCIT exam to achieve certification. PCIT International maintains a list of PCIT Certified Therapists at <http://www.pcit.org/certified-therapists.html>

PCIT International requires therapists to renew their certification every 2 years by submitting an application with documentation of the therapist completing 3 hours of PCIT Continuing Education credits.
